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stormwater MS4 general permit from DEP; by 2026 need GIS mapping; need to walk 26 miles of streets and use GIS to hit a button at each storm drain; Scout project – Dave spoke with Westfield with 1700 drains (300 sponsored), can see all drains through Hamlin University annual cost \$2,100, estimate cost to clean each drain is \$200 so it has a very positive cost benefit analysis – access to adoption rates, can have competitions, provide marketing materials – Westfield used Clean Communities grant money to pay for cost; item for Trish

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DISCUSSION		
 131 Hunter Ave – mini mansion built and built up yard from soil moved from basement of new construction; escrow collection started for inspections; 127 Hunter clear cut lot (3 yrs ago) without approval, then planning board approval, grading was maintained; 131 Hunter moved in last year & had water in yard, all clay soils, clear cuts lot here as well, ordinance doesn't require planting if dead trees removed; recommended storm pit in yard which didn't work; now wants town to help with drainage; drain in front of property, could put in pump in storm pit and pump to drain 102 Willoughby – built house 2 years ago; added 200 ft2 patio goes right up to property line, water is piling up on neighbors; additional drainage is required, patio needs to be moved; Antonis to send out letter 165 Westfield Road – shed + gazebo addition; stormwater management activities are needed; 		
 Library plantings update – Leslie to forward plans to Antonios Pat currently has them; planting planned for March 2024
