### Andrea: 4/20 Clean Communities Day - NC clean-up - work with Clint regarding:

- Include "Fanwood Nature Center 50th Anniversary" on the back of clean-up day shirts
- Call-out in Clean Communities communications that we'd like volunteers to specifically clean the NC stream/ requires appropriate rain boots/ gloves/ tick prevention

### **Phyllis:** Nature Center Map and Bible Chapel Contacts

- By 4/20 (ideally): Update Nature Center map to be printed and posted at entrance/ generate QR code for visitors instead of printing more paper maps map has been updated & needs to be hosted at a specific website location (to be placed on the FEC website) & then generate a QR code to be posted.
- Bible Chapel contact re usage of their parking lot for NC events sharing church with a 2nd ministry, but with advanced notice, use of parking lot is ok.

### Sandy/ Leslie: Second NC Clean-Up (spring)

- Primary activity: community volunteers to help plant native species; need to assess extent of preliminary clean-up to remove poison ivy, etc. beforehand
- Secondary idea if feasible: utilize church parking lot for TBD such as food truck/ scream truck/ italian ice
- Bird box dedication assuming scouts will have them up by the time of this event
- Scheduled for 5/4, rain date 5/5.
- Considering building bike racks for each entrance from used pallets. Need to locate people with proper tools.

Update (4/18): Sandy, Leslie and Phyllis toured the NC to review work. TRAIL MAINTE-NANCE DAY: Rake leaves and remove branches from trail, clean up benches, plant native plants, add footings on sagging part of boardwalk, replace boards, remove invasive plants hanging over trails, etc. Date - May 4 9:00 a.m. (rain date is May 5).

#### Leslie/ Andrea: Dhammakaya-led morning mediation at the NC (summer)

- Visit Dhammakaya to gauge interest in hosting a one-time morning meditation or a summer morning meditation series- confirmed interest.
- Could take place near the northeast (power line) entrance/ would need to be mowed (DPW?) and "bring your own mat"; could also use parking lot of Terrill Bible

#### Suzanne: "Scouts Day at the Nature Center" (fall)

- Coordinate what girl and boy scout points can be satisfied in a few hours at the nature center/ what date works best for max. attendance
- Activity: photo scavenger hunt (ID'ing plants/animals, etc.)
- Bat box dedication assuming scouts with have them up by the time of this event
- Peace pole dedication if girl scouts can refurbish by the time of this event
