LOT 9 – FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

1. What is the location of Lot 9?

- Lot 9 is the large parking lot located behind 246-250 South Avenue, and 32-56 South Martine Avenue. Entrances to the lot are located on Second Street and LaGrande Avenue.
- While most of the parking lot is owned and maintained by the Borough of Fanwood, portions of the parking lot behind 220–230 South Avenue are privately owned. Signage is posted identifying the distinction between Borough-owned and privately owned parking areas.

2. What are the current parking regulations in Lot 9?

- In most areas of the lot, parking is limited to 2 hours between 5:00am and 11:00pm, Monday through Friday.
- For parking spaces directly adjacent to the businesses, parking is limited to 2 hours between 5:00am and 11:00pm, Monday through Friday. Additionally, no parking is permitted in those spaces from 11:00pm to 5:00am, seven days a week.
- Parking is free on weekends and holidays.

3. On what date is enforcement expected to begin?

- Enforcement is expected to begin on June 1, 2026.

4. Who qualifies for a parking permit in Lot 9?

- Residents of 246 South Avenue, 250 South Avenue, and 233 LaGrande Avenue qualify for resident permits. Certain qualifying businesses are also eligible for merchant permits.
- Vehicles displaying valid permits are exempt from the 2-hour parking limitation, with the exception of the spaces directly adjacent to the businesses. .

5. How do I qualify to receive a resident parking permit?

- You must be a qualifying resident or business to receive a permit. If you believe you qualify, please email police@fanwoodnj.org to request a permit application.

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6. What are the rules for Resident Permits?

- Permits are issued to specific vehicles and are non-transferable. If a resident changes vehicles, the Police Department must be notified by emailing police@fanwoodnj.org
- Residents must submit a recent proof of residency, such as a utility bill or current lease.
- Permits are valid from the date of issuance remain valid as long as the resident continues to reside at an eligible address.
- Replacement resident permits are charged at \$25.00 per permit for lost permits.

7. What are the rules for Merchant Permits?

- Merchant permits are issued to the business, in care of the business owner, and may be transferred between employees of that business.
- Merchant permits are valid from the date of issuance and do not expire.
- Replacement resident permits are charged at \$25.00 per permit for lost permits.

8. Where can excess vehicles park so as not receive parking violations?

- Lot 9 permits 2-hour parking for most of the week, and parking is free on Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays in most sections of the lot.
- Vehicles may park free of charge at the Fanwood Train Station between 12:00pm and 5:00am, Monday through Friday. Parking at the train station is also free on weekends and holidays.
- Additional street parking without time restrictions is available on portions of Second Street, LaGrande Avenue, Helen Street, and other nearby Borough roads outside of the downtown area.

9. Does the permit need to be displayed on the vehicle?

- Resident permits **must** be affixed to the vehicle and clearly visible at all times. Merchant permits must either be affixed to the vehicle or clearly displayed on the vehicle dashboard.
- Failure to properly display a permit may result in the issuance of a summons.

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
