WIC is a Supplemental Nutrition and Breastfeeding Program administered by the USDA for New Jersey residents who meet the income guidelines. Services include nutrition, health and breastfeeding education, referrals to other community resources and electronic food benefits for income-eligible pregnant women, breastfeeding and postpartum women (six months after delivery), infants and children up to 5 years old. Eligibility is determined during pre-screening.
